Frequently Asked Questions...

What is the MAPP Exam (Graduation Exit Exam)?

The **Measure of Academic Proficiency and Progress** is a test of academic knowledge and skills acquired through undergraduate general education courses. **The test is a graduation requirement** and is used to assess university goals described in the *AASU catalog* as general education outcomes. CAUTION: The MAPP does not substitute for your exit exam in your major field. Consult your academic advisor or department head about other examinations required for graduation.

What does it cover?

The Measure of Academic Proficiency and Progress (MAPP) test is a measure of college-level reading, mathematics, writing, and critical thinking in the context of the humanities, social sciences, and natural sciences. It focuses on the academic skills developed through general education courses, rather than on the knowledge acquired about the subjects taught in these courses.

What if I cannot attend my scheduled test session?

If you are absent or expect to be absent, please call the Student Affairs Office (912) 344-2582 at least 5 business days prior to your scheduled test to reschedule for a different date. Request received after the registration deadline will not be honored.

May I take the test before my final term of enrollment?

You must have the test information and request form with the test date for which you register in order to pay for your test. This form is issued by the Assistant Registrar upon his receipt of a Graduation Application. You may ask the Assistant Registrar, located in Victor Hall, to approve an early test date and provide the request form.

Test Takers with Disabilities

If you have a disability, contact the AASU [Office of Disability Services](#), in order to take the test with accommodations that meet your needs.

How do I pay for the exam?

Cash or Check in Person:

Take the Registration Form and fee to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Make checks payable to AASU

Visa/Mastercard in Person:

Take Registration Form, Credit Card and Identification to the Bursars Office in Burnett Hall, Monday-Friday, 8:30a.m-4:30 p.m.

Late Registration: Students who fail to meet the listed registration deadlines or miss the test date will be assessed a **\$10 late fee** for processing purposes.
