- **ATLANTA:** take I-75 south to I-16 east, then I-95 south to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **ALBANY:** take Highway 82 east to Highway 84 east, north on I-95 to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **AUGUSTA:** take Highway 278 east to Highway 125 south to Highway 278 east. Take I-95 south to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **CHARLESTON:** take Highway 17 south to I-95 south to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **COLUMBUS:** Take Highway 96 east to I-16 east, then I-95 south to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **JACKSONVILLE:** take I-95 north to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **MACON:** take I-16 east, then I-95 south to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
- **VALDOSTA:** take Highway 84 east to I-95 north to Highway 204 east (Exit 94). Then follow the map at left.
